Parents & Carers Code of Conduct

Our club is committed to providing a safe, respectful and positive environment for all members. Parents and carers play an important role in supporting this.

By allowing your child to train at JKS Llanbedr DC Karate Club, you agree to the following:

1. Respect & Behaviour

- Treat all children, instructors, volunteers and other parents with respect
 - Encourage your child to show good sportsmanship, discipline and respect — values central to karate
 - Never use abusive, aggressive or discriminatory language or behaviour at the venue or online
 - Do not undermine instructors in front of children
 - All students must wear appropriate clothing during training. Where necessary for dignity and safeguarding, suitable garments should be worn beneath the gi top.
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2. Safeguarding

- Follow all club safeguarding rules and policies
 - Report any welfare concerns to the Safeguarding Lead — not through social media or gossip
 - Do not approach another child regarding behaviour or disputes — speak to an instructor instead
 - Ensure emergency contact and medical information for your child is kept up to date
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3. Attendance & Supervision

- Ensure your child arrives on time and is collected promptly
- Remain responsible for your child outside class times



- Inform the instructor if someone different is collecting your child
 - Young children should not be left unsupervised before or after sessions
 - Please attend at the door to prevent your child walking alone across roads/car park
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4. Photography & Social Media

- Do not photograph or film other children without permission
 - Never post images or videos of other members online without consent
 - Do not discuss club issues or individuals negatively on social media
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5. Communication with Instructors

- Use respectful communication at all times
 - Raise concerns privately and calmly
 - Allow instructors to focus on coaching during sessions — arrange separate time for longer discussions
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6. Supporting a Positive Training Environment

- Encourage effort and learning, not just winning or grading success
 - Accept that instructors make decisions in the best interests of safety and development
 - Help your child follow dojo rules, uniform standards and behaviour expectations
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7. Breaches of This Code

Failure to follow this code may result in:

- A conversation with club leadership
 - Restrictions on attendance at sessions or events
 - In serious cases, termination of membership
